All Canadian Lakes' members, their parents, children, and grandchildren are invited to participate in our year around ANNUALYOUTH BIG FISH AWARDS AND LARGEST FISH COMPETITION. Both will use the same entry form. Simply complete and send the entry form below, along with a photo of the fish and angler (if possible). All measurements are by length only.

Awards will be made in November to every youth, age 14 and under, who enters a fish.

A separate award and \$10 prize will be awarded for the largest fish entered by anyone in each species. There is a minimum length for each species, to be eligible for the largest fish Award and Prize.

The fish must be caught within Canadian Lakes boundaries, in conformance with CL and MDNR Regulations. All Largemouth Bass, Pike, and Muskie in open water must be caught with an artificial lure and released live. Bass, Pike and Muskie can also be caught through the ice, but must be released live.

Contests run from October 1, 2022, to September 30, 2023, Entries must be received by October 10, 2023.

Competitors for Largest Fish can enter multiple fish species, but each must be above minimum entry length.

Youth age 14 and below can enter multiple fish of any length, but can only receive one youth award, and must be for a species for which they do not already have a prior year award.

(Youth entries are eligible for both the Youth and Largest Fish competition)
