Registration deadline 6 p.m. Fri, Sept 8.

**WHO** All Canadian Lake's members, family and guests accompanied by a member. *(Any number may be in a boat but this is an individual tournament.)*

**WHEN** Meeting at 7:45 a.m. at Pierce Beach on West Lake. Fishing starts at 8 a.m. (Rain or Shine) Bring your own refreshments.

**FEE** \$20 per person *(Jr. Anglers 16 and under are free, with separate prizes)*

**LOCATION** Fishing can be in any of the Canadian Lakes, from boat or shore, but participants must register at Pierce Beach by 8 a.m. and return by 2 p.m.

**PRIZES** (25% of entry fee to cover cost) 4 Cash prizes from the remaining 75%, to those paying entry fee:

**Longest Pike or Muskie**, 35% (Tie breaker - next longest)

**Total inches of Pike and Muskie 24" and over**, 25%  
(Tie breaker total # of fish caught)

**2nd Longest Pike**, 20% (Tie breaker - most # caught)

**Most # of fish caught**, Pike and Muskie, 20%  
(Tie breaker longest)

Prizes can be won in combination.  
Tournament director is ineligible for prizes.

**RULES** Only artificial lures are allowed.

One rod at a time per fisherman, trolling is allowed.

All Pike and Muskies caught are to be measured to nearest ¼ inch, documented on a form provided and must be released live immediately.

Measurements must be taken with fish mouth closed and tail squeezed together.

Fisherman must bring a digital camera/ phone with a camera to photograph any fish being considered for the longest fish prize.

Send entry fee labeled "2023 Pike Tournament" along with names of fishermen to Jeff Abel, 9325 Edgewater Drive, by Sept. 8 or bring to a Fishing club meeting or event before that date.
